Buskers do have to obtain a Permit which are issued free of charge from the Council. Persons under the age of 15 years must produce written consent from their parents before a Permit can be issued.

A SUMMARY...

Mobile Shop Licence

Applications for a Mobile Shop Licence can be made at the Council Office.

There are some conditions which apply to the issue of these licences—

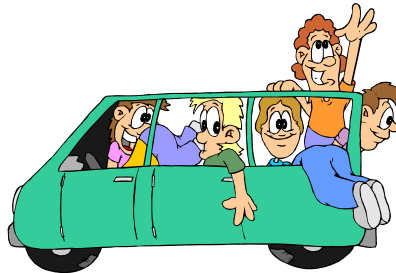
- The vehicle and depot must comply with the standards prescribed by the Food Hygiene Regulations 1974.
- Vending is not permitted in the Central Business areas of the towns of Levin, Foxton and Shannon.
- Vending is not permitted in any reserve except with the prior written permission of Council.
- Vending is not permitted within 100 metres of any shop selling similar goods.
- Chimes or other forms of advertising, including recorded or amplified sound must be controlled, so as not to be a nuisance or mask the sound of approaching traffic.



- The vehicle is not to remain stationary in any street or public place except for such reasonable time as is required to complete transaction of business with customers.
- The operator is responsible for collecting and removing litter generated in the immediate vicinity of the vehicle as a result of its trading operations.
- The operator is to have their name legibly displayed in letters not less than 25 mm in height in a conspicuous place on the exterior of the vehicle or mobile shop.



- The licence shall be carried by the operator at all times when selling from the vehicle, and shall be produced on request.



Hawkers

Hawking (Selling of goods) door to door is not allowed within the District unless a licence has first been obtained. A fee is payable at the time of application.

Applications for hawking can be made by contacting our Customer Service Centre.

Fundraising for charities and organisations is permitted and registration of such activities can be made at the Council office.
