	The economic development potential is also great as interest and use of the network grows. New and existing businesses such as bike hire, cafes and accommodation will evolve to service these new activities. This will create training and employment opportunities. To progress the Shared Pathway Network significant investment is required. Whilst there are potentially some other external funding streams for specific pathway projects, I urge Council to allocate \$250,000 for 2017/2018 to maximise the speed at which our pathways can be delivered to our quickly growing population.
