## C3 Foxton War Memorial Hall Proposed Transfer to Interim Committee

The purpose of this report is to inform Council of current developments in relation to the proposed transfer of Foxton War Memorial Hall to the Foxton War Memorial Hall Society Incorporated (FWMHSI) and seek a decision from Council on the future of the Foxton War Memorial Hall.

### Resolution Number CO/2023/1

MOVED by Mayor Wanden, seconded Cr Brannigan:

That Report 23/423 Foxton War Memorial Hall Proposed Transfer to Interim Committee be received.

That this matter or decision is recognised as not significant in terms of S76 of the Local Government Act.

During debate on this item, Councillors acknowledged the work that had been put in by the Society in developing the business case. However, concern was expressed about the viability of the project given the current low NBS rating, the significant cost of obtaining a seismic assessment and remediation plan, and the ability of the society to meet those costs.

Concern was also noted that the business case insufficiently identified an ongiong income stream to maintain the business.

Officers advised that a previous assessment had suggested that the building could be strengthened to 44% of NBS – this was considered an inadequate level for public building. At that time a remediation plan to bring he building up to minimum 67% of NBS was not put forward as that assessment indicated that to do so would involve the complete re-build of the hall.

### MMOVED by Cr Allen, seconded by Cr Jennings

That Council grants a further 12 months extension until 30 June 2024, to allow the FWMHSI to provide further detail in relation to its plans for earthquake strengthening, renewals, insurance and the management of health and safety, and its organisational hierarchy; that this matter be brought before Council again at the end of that extension for further consideration.

Concerns remained over the viability of the of the business case, and whether giving the Society more time to develop further would result in a more viable outcome either in the business case itself, or suitability and stability of the building.

That Council request Officers complete the transfer to FWMHSI of the Foxton War Memorial Hall in line with the resolution outlined in the Council meeting of 26 May 2021, noting the documentation provided by the FWMHSI, and evidence provided

by the Working Party, and further that the Chief Executive be delegated authority to finalise the transfer and appropriate conditions, which will provide a 24 month period for the FWMHSI to develop a robust plan for earthquake strengthening and financial sustainability, otherwise the building will return to Council's ownership.
