**DECISION**

I, as Chairman, make this Decision in accordance with Section 136(4)(a)

I have before me an application by **IR Hospitality Limited** for a temporary authority in respect of premises situated at **53 Oxford Street Levin**.

The application for the temporary authority was filed with the District Licensing Committee on the 28 May 2025. It is the First such application made by this applicant.

The inspector has filed a report on the application and does not oppose the granting of the temporary authority. The Police have reported on the application and offer no opposition to the granting of the temporary authority.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which I must have regard, and I am satisfied that the application meets the Purpose and Object of the Act, accordingly, I grant the temporary authority. The temporary authority authorises the applicant to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol of licence number 40/ON/004/2024 from **30 June 2025 to 29 September 2025**.

The conditions of the temporary authority will be the same as those of the underlying licence AND further conditions follow:

- (ii) The licensee must obtain a full licence by **30 September 2025**;
- (iii) Suitable and Approved ID must be checked where any person purchasing alcohol appears under 25 years of age;
- (iii) Information and contact details for alternative transport must be clearly displayed by a telephone available for public access. Staff must be available to assist with transportation requirements when necessary.

The temporary authority may issue immediately, for the period not exceeding three months.
