

Horowhenua District Licensing Committee Uncontested Applications Decision

Authority

The functions, powers and duties as the District Licensing Committee is delegated to the committee chairperson where no objection has been filed, and no matters of opposition have been raised by the Police, Medical Officer of Health, and Inspector, in respect of the following application:

> an application for a renewal of a Club Licence – Hydra Enterprises Limited

Statutory Provisions

- Section 191(2) of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (The Act)
- Council resolution dated 4 December 2013 (TRIM document D13/102672);
- There is no Local Alcohol Policy in place.

Summary of Evidence

Reports from Police, Medical Officer of Health, and an Inspector appointed under the Act do not now oppose the issue of the application. Based on the information provided to me on the complete files, I have determined not to convene public hearing.

Evaluation of Evidence

I have considered this application on the basis of the reports received where the objection that was raised by the Medical Officer of Health has now been withdrawn, and noted that there have also been no public objection. In considering whether to grant the On Licence I have also considered the criteria set out in Section 131 of the Act.

Decision and Reasons

All reports are satisfactory now and the objection was withdrawn to this Renewal Licence. I therefore conclude there is no reason not to grant this application.

There is one condition to this decision and that is that the New Single Alcohol Area as shown on the proposed floor plan be completed no later than 21 July 2017 and that as soon as the changers have happened the proposed floor plan becomes the single alcohol area for the premises.

Therefore I determine that the application be granted as follows by way of Decision Number 114/2016
