

As of March 2023, the Horowhenua District's population reached 36,693, according to the 2023 Census. This reflects an increase of 3,432 people—or 10.3%—since the 2018 Census. While the 2023 Census figures fall slightly below projected population estimates, the District continues to experience significant growth, making Horowhenua the 10th fastest-growing district in New Zealand.
