Māori Ward Poll - Horowhenua District Council

A poll will be held in conjunction with the above elections to confirm whether Horowhenua District Council electors wish to keep or remove the Māori Ward as part of Horowhenua District Council's representation structure. The outcome of the poll is binding and will determine whether a Māori Ward will be retained for the Horowhenua District Council elections in 2028 and 2031. The First Past the Post (FPP) Electoral System will be used for this poll.
