I refer to your request for information received on 8 August 2022. Your request has been considered under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) and I provide the following information.

Information on jobs loaded regarding the flooding issue with the Ōhau underpass

Horowhenua District Council's Customer Request Management system has been checked for customer enquiries relating to flooding at the underpass in Ōhau at the intersection of Muhunoa West Road and Muhunoa East Road (underneath State Highway 1).

How many people have complained?

In total there have been 14 enquiries related to flooding at the underpass at Ōhau (underneath State Highway 1) since September 2017.

198208	21-Dec-21	Customer has requested a call back regarding the flooding at the Ohau underpass, she said with it being closed children are now having to cross the road at the State Highway - she is concerned about how dangerous this is and has asked if there are any plans to try and pump some of the water

198239	21-Dec-21	Customer has called about the Ohau underpass being flooded and people having to cross SH1 if they want to get across the road - which is very dangerous. She has been advised that we have asked Higgins if it's possible to pump, but with more rain and a high water table it may just fill up again. School is closed for the year but customer is adamant she wants it open to cross safely by the end of the day for the local children. Customer said Council used to have a pump there with a red light to show when the underpass was flooded but that hasn't been maintained for at least 6 years and it's just not good enough that they can't use the underpass if it's raining heavily. What if this happened during the school term? Customer is going to advise the Chronicle and put what she has been told all over facebook. Can we please call her back with an indication of what we can achieve here, thanks.
205492	9-May-22	The HDC Ohau Underpass Asset ID 119626 is starting to flood with water, customer says it is up to your ankles and getting worse - can we please check out the pump to make sure it is working.
207291	13-Jun-22	Customer would like to talk to Roading Officer regarding the bypass that floods by Ohau School. Customer said he has a solution to resolve the issue. Can you please call him back.
210458	30-Jul-22	A new RFS 1273041 has been added with the following details RFS Started: 30-Jul-2022 10:24 Call In: 10:23am Issue Location: State Highway 1, Levin Details: Customer has called to adivse the Ohau underpass is flooded which intersects at Muhunoa East Road and State Highway 1 Problem Type: Flooding on Street If Grate - where is it: (Unknown) Duty Officer Contacted: Spoke to Officer 10:36am
210678	8-Aug-22	Customer has advised there is a lot of flooding on Muhunoa East Road, by Ohau School, extending to the underpass. Children cannot walk across the road to the school, as it is knee high, and filling up their gumboots This is a safety issue as children cannot walk along the State High to get to school, there is no other alternative. Customer called at 7:15am today, requesting the roading team to go out and assess the underpass this morning.
210869	9-Aug-22	Muhunoa East Road, Ohau Details: Customer has called to advise that the subway under the main road is flooded and kids use it to get to school.
