

Thank you for your email dated 19 May 2025 requesting under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), information relating to Horowhenua District Council confiscating Maori land. Please see outlined below a response to each part of your request.

Please advise details of Maori land that HDC has confiscated since its inception.

We do not hold any records of any Māori land that has been confiscated by Horowhenua District Council.

Please advise details of Maori land that was confiscated by HDC's territorial authority predecessors.

We do not hold any records of any land that has been confiscated by Horowhenua District Council predecessors.

This matter may fall more appropriately within the remit of the Waitangi Tribunal and Land Information New Zealand.
