Thank you for your email dated 2 July 2025 requesting, under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA), information relating to consultancy fees paid by Horowhenua District Council for each of the last five completed financial years (FY 2019/20 to FY 2023/24), and the current financial year to date.
