Levin Waste Transfer Station – 2003	Nearest residential dwelling was built in 1962
Shannon Waste Transfer Station – 1996	Nearest residential dwelling was built in 1910
Foxton Waste Transfer Station – 1996	Nearest residential dwelling was built in 1910
