4. 1 Delegated Authority to Approve Operating Expenditure

Purpose

To seek Council's approval for the Chief Executive, or if he is unavailable, for the Deputy Chief Executive, to execute the agreement with Council's preferred energy supplier (following completion of a competitive tender process) for the contract amount which exceeds their delegated authority.

Mrs Brady spoke to the report explaining in some detail the reasons behind the urgency involved in terms of the very tight pricing windows (two to five days) that energy suppliers were currently working to and how delaying a decision could ultimately affect the price that Council could pay for its electricity and gas supply going forward.
