5 Infrastructure Operations

5.1 Foxton Beach Surf Life Saving Building - Lease

Purpose

To seek a resolution from Council to authorise the Chief Executive to enter into a new Deed of Lease with the Foxton Surf and Life Saving Club Incorporated (the Club) for the Foxton Beach Surf Life Saving building.

Council's Parks & Property Lead North, Sean Hester, gave an overview of the report and a background to the Club's request for the granting of a new long term lease.

Speaking on behalf of the Club, Mr Adam Radich stressed the importance of the Club to the area, its history and potential future with the predicted growth for the district.

Acknowledged by both speakers was the partnership between the Club and Council Officers which had seen significant funding attracted from Central Government for a much needed upgrade to the Surf Club building. Mr Radich stressed the importance of timing, with an MOU between the Club and Council to be signed, tenders were due this Friday (26 February), with procurement to be undertaken next week and the successful tenderer to be announced on 5 March.
