#### 5 Reports for Decision

#### 5.1 Adoption of the Consultation Document and associated Supporting Information for the Long Term Plan 2021-2041 Amendment and Annual Plan 2023/2024

Mr McCorkindale joined the table to outline the legislation changes that had progressed through Government since the Council meeting last week which now cleared the way for Council to receive a lawful adverse opinion rather than an unlawful one.

Mr McCorkindale explained the 'Working with Māori' document was previously called 'Development of Māori Capacity to Contribute to Decision Making'. This document was updated to reflect some changes, whilst a full review will take place as part of the Long Term Plan proper, which will commence in a few months' time, the updates were made to reflect current context.

Audit New Zealand Director, Mr Ramoo confirmed that following legislative changes in the past week, Audit NZ were now in a position to provide a lawful (instead of unlawful) adverse opinion. The adverse opinion is a result of Council showing Three Waters information beyond 2024.

It was reaffirmed by Mayor Wanden, that Council continues to be of the view that it is correct to show the Three Waters programme beyond 2024, in the Long Term Plan. It is for these reasons that the LTPA will attract an adverse audit opinion, which Council accepts.
