Potholing Investigation Works - York Street, Levin

As part of our stormwater upgrade and renewal programme, potholing investigation works will take place on York Street, Levin to prepare for future construction.

Planned start date: Tuesday 12 December 2023 Expected completion date: Wednesday 20 December 2023

Work Hours: 7.30am to 5.30pm Affected area: York Street, Levin

Potholing is done to find exact location and depth of underground utilities such as pipes and services. The process will involve digging a small hole into the ground to find the pipes. This work is to prepare for water and sewer pipes renewal

along York Street. Main pipe laying works will start during late January 2024.

Higgins Contractors will do the investigative work on behalf of Horowhenua District Council using a non-destructive hydrovaccing truck for excavation. All potholes will be backfilled by the end of the working day. The work will not impact road traffic.

Disruptions will be kept to a minimum while the work is being undertaken and the work will be signposted. Thank you for your patience and cooperation.

It would be a treat if you can keep me out of the heat

Our Animal Control Team would like to remind you that it gets crazy hot in vehicles, especially on warm days.

Leaving your dog alone in a vehicle can be seriously dangerous. Even with windows open, a dark-coloured vehicle parked in full sun on a day with an ambient temperature of 22°C can reach an internal temperature of 40°C after 10 minutes.

Beach Recycling Stations

Foxton Beach

A recycling station is located on Seabury Avenue and available from mid-December to mid-March.

Waitārere Beach

A recycling station is located in the Waitārere Beach car park and is available all year round.

Waikawa Beach

A recycling station is located near the toilet block by the reserve and is available from mid-December to early January. Please recycle approved material only. No recycling after 6.30pm or before 8am.

Christmas and New Year Kerbside Recycling and Rubbish Collection

Kerbside collection will continue as normal, with the exception of Christmas Day and New Year's Day. There will be no kerbside collections on Monday 25 December, or Monday 1 January.

The collection which would normally happen on **Monday 25 December** will take place earlier on **Saturday 23 December**.


The Monday 1 January collection will take place on Saturday 30 December. Please check your collection dates on Council's website.
